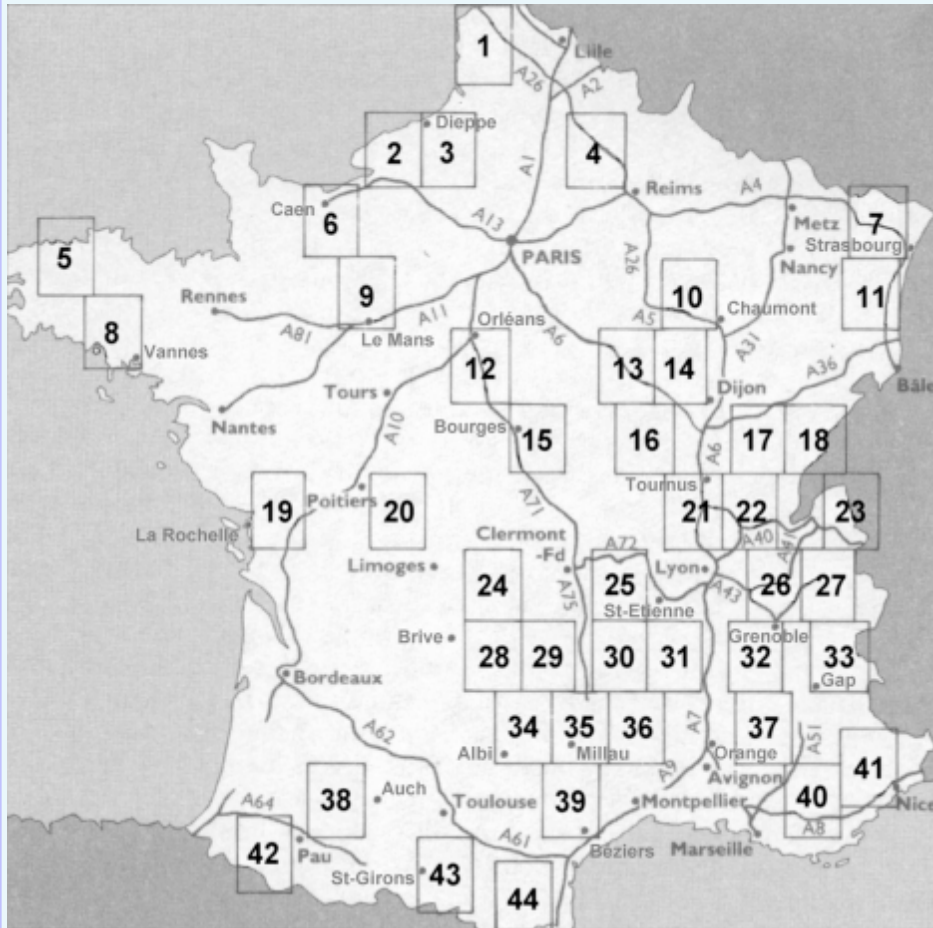


Notes on Maps, Text and Contents page opposite



- 1) The map numbers above correspond to the first column of numbers on the opposite page.
- 2) Many places of interest – towns, villages, rivers and other sights – referred to in each area’s text (in **bold print**) are shown on the corresponding map in black/grey print • **Fontgombault**
- 3) A letter and number (A1, C3, etc.), following any place name, refers to the grid square on that chapter’s *aide-mémoire* map.
- 4) The illustration on page 2, Belcastel, is from the front cover of *Mapaholics’ France*; see pages 144 and 147.
- 5) Map scales 1/600 000: 1 cm is 6 km; 1 inch is just under 10 miles.
- 6) Map tints:

under 200m/660ft		200m/660ft to 1000m/3300ft	
1000m/3300ft to 3000m/9900ft		over 3000m/9900ft
